

Enrollment During First Fall Immediately After High School by Gender Effective as of: April 21, 2022







Enrollment During First Fall Immediately After High School by Economic Disadvantage Effective as of: April 21, 2022





Enrollment During First Fall Immediately After High School by Disability Effective as of: April 21, 2022





Enrollment During First Fall Immediately After High School by English Language Learner Effective as of: April 21, 2022





Enrollment Any Time During the First Year After High School by Gender Effective as of: April 21, 2022





Enrollment Any Time During the First Two Years After High School by Disability Effective as of: April 21, 2022





Enrollment during First Year After High School Who Returned for a Second Year by Economic Disadvantage Effective as of: April 21, 2022




